SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

Each year ACSA Region I will award scholarships during the month of May to graduating high school seniors who have a parent/care-giver who is a member of ACSA Region I and works in a school district in Region I. The number of scholarships varies each year, but there will be no less than five \$1,000 scholarships awarded for the 2004-2005 school year. For the 2003-2004 school year, four \$1,000 scholarships were awarded. Application packets may be obtained from the secondary school representative listed below or are available on the Internet at www.anderson.k12.ca.us or the Region I website <http://www.acsaregion1.org/>.

ELIGIBILITY – The applicant must:

1. Be a child of or under the guardianship of a Region 1 ACSA member.
2. Be a graduating high school senior in the year in which the scholarship is awarded.
3. Have a 3.0 minimum cumulative grade point average (unweighted).

CRITERIA FOR SELECTION:

1. Grade point average in courses completed.
2. In-school and outside-of-school participation in leadership and activities.
3. Plans for college and/or future career training.

APPLICATION PROCESS

1. The completed application must consist of the following five items:
 - An essay not to exceed 300 words dealing with the importance of having advanced education/training.
 - An application form filled out by the applicant.
 - A copy of the applicant's transcripts in a sealed envelope.
 - Three letters of recommendation, each sealed in an envelope by the reference person, at least one must be from a staff member.
 - A photograph picture of the applicant; winner's pictures will be published.
2. A completed application must be postmarked by **Friday, April 8, 2005**. The application must be sent to the current secondary school representative below:
